

**Blue Ridge Community College
Motorcycle Safety Courses
Spring 2009**

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE: Registrations will be received **after** March 22, 2009. Any registrations received earlier will be returned. All participating students must register, including 2-up passengers. The Basic Rider Course (BRC) and Experienced Rider Course (ERC) offered by Blue Ridge Community College are approved by the National Motorcycle Safety Foundation and the North Carolina Motorcycle Safety Education Program. BASIC RIDER COURSE, (BRC)

FEE \$175

This course is for persons who have never been on a motorcycle as well as for anyone who wishes to improve their riding skills. **Ability to balance and sufficient strength to handle a motorcycle is necessary for successful completion of course.** Students must possess a valid driver's license or learner's permit before enrolling. As of May 1, 1995, the North Carolina DMV will accept the MSF Course Completion Card as a substitute for the skills test when applying for the motorcycle endorsement. **Program motorcycles are provided and must be used in the Basic Rider Course.** BRC classes meet from 6:00 to 10:00 p.m. on Friday in the Motorcycle/Masonry Bldg and 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday at the Patton Parking Lot. Students must attend the entire 20 hour course and pass written and riding skills tests before receiving the Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) Course Completion Card. **The range training may extend past 5 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday depending on progression of training.**

EXPERIENCED RIDER COURSE (ERC)

FEE \$70

2-UP PASSENGERS (ERC class only)

FEE \$30

This course is for the rider with at least six months or 3,000 miles riding experience. Students must possess a valid driver's license or learner's permit before enrolling. Students will need to furnish a street-legal, properly licensed and insured motorcycle of any size. If the motorcycle is not registered in the student's name, written permission from the owner to use the motorcycle must be furnished. All motorcycles will be inspected for proper and safe condition with particular attention to tires. If you normally carry a passenger, your passenger will also need to register and pay the 2-Up Passenger fee. ERC classes meet from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., on Saturday or Sunday at the Patton Parking Lot. Students must attend the full 8 hr course to receive the MSF Completion card.

PROPER RIDING GEAR:

Notice: Proper riding gear must be worn at all times while attending the course, including Friday evening.

ALL STUDENTS MUST WEAR:

- Helmet and Eye Protection:** The helmet must meet DOT standards and can be full face, ¾ or ½ in design. Helmets with obvious defects such as no lining, a cracked shell, or defective chinstrap will not be used. Sunglasses meet the eye protection requirement.
- Over the ankle Footwear:** Shoes should be predominantly leather in construction and cover the anklebone. High top athletic shoes that meet the above criteria may be worn.
- Pants:** Pant legs should reach the shoe tops and be made preferably of denim or a material of equivalent durability.
- Long-sleeve shirt or jacket:** If the student chooses to wear a long-sleeve shirt, a jacket is not required. A shirt with sleeves to the wrist made of a durable material is preferred. The shirt should cover the rider's shoulders (no shoulder cutouts allowed).
- Gloves:** Gloves should be full fingered and preferable made of leather. Style and material are the student's choice.

COURSE WITHDRAWAL POLICY:
